

REGULATIONS

Article 1.

The founder of the competition is the Music School of Bačka Topola, and the organizer is the association "Odeon."

Article 2.

Participants in the competition may be regular students of primary and secondary music schools from the following departments: violin, viola, cello, double bass, piano, guitar, flute, clarinet, saxophone, oboe, bassoon, trumpet, horn, trombone, tuba, and percussion instruments, as well as music academy students of the guitar department.

Article 3.

The competition is public, and the program is performed from memory, except for chamber ensembles and wind instruments, where the program may be performed from sheet music. Percussion instruments perform the program on rhythmic instruments from sheet music and from memory on melodic instruments.

Article 4.

The competition is judged by a jury composed of eminent professors from music schools in our country and abroad.

Article 5.

The jury's decision is final and irrevocable.

Article 6.

The jury ranks participants as follows:

I Prize: 90 to 100 points

II Prize: 80 to 89.99 points

III Prize: 70 to 79.99 points

Honorable Mention: 60 to 69.99 points

Participants who score 95 points or more receive a GOLD MEDAL.

A diploma and the title of laureate in each discipline will be awarded by the jury to one participant each from the primary music school, secondary music school, and music academy, who achieves a perfect score of 100 points.

Teachers and accompanists will receive a certificate of appreciation for their pedagogical work and contribution to the competition.

The youngest participant in the entire event will receive a special award.

Participants who perform their own composition (original work) or a composition written by their teacher will receive a certificate of appreciation for their artistic contribution to the 'Days of Music' event.

Article 7.

After each category, students and their teachers will have the opportunity to consult with jury members after the results are announced.

Article 8.

The participation fee includes a video recording of the participant's performance. After the event, each participant will receive a recording of their performance in electronic format.

Article 9.

APPLICATION FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE COMPETITION MUST BE SUBMITTED EXCLUSIVELY THROUGH THE GOOGLE FORMS REGISTRATION FORM. The registration form will be published later on the competition website. Candidates are required to submit the following documents in their application:

- Confirmation from the school regarding the grade the candidate is attending
- Birth certificate copy (for foreign participants: scanned passport)
- Proof of payment of the registration fee
